

## **FAQs: Tuition**

### **How much is the tuition and what does it cover?**

Preschool: \$6665/year Includes tuition, instructional materials, lunch, Extended Care (before and after school).

Elementary: \$7285/year Includes tuition, textbooks & instructional materials, technology costs

Middle School: \$7990/year Includes tuition, textbooks & instructional materials, technology costs

High School: \$8715/year Includes tuition, textbooks & instructional materials, technology costs

“Tuition” at all levels includes a per student share of the cost of teaching staff, administrative & support staff, facility costs and utilities. The variance in tuition at the different grade levels is due to the fact that upper levels require more teachers and utilize more classrooms to serve their instructional and operational needs. (i.e. our preschool students use one classroom with one teacher, whereas our high school students utilize multiple classrooms and multiple teachers each day.)

### **What are the tuition due dates?**

Tuition payments in our monthly payment plans are due on the first day of each month. For tuition not paid by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month, a late fee of \$35.00 is assessed.

### **What are the tuition payment options?**

NCCS offers monthly payment plans on 12 month, 11 month, and 10 month schedules. Most families choose to use one of our monthly payment plans. However, we also offer a full-pay option in which parents may pay the full tuition by July 1 to receive a 2% discount.

### **Are there additional costs besides tuition?**

Yes. In addition to tuition, there is an annual registration fee of \$150 for each student. We charge athletic fees for students who participate in our athletic programs. There may also be a small cost associated with some field trips.

### **Why is there an Annual Fund and other fundraising activities on top of tuition costs?**

Gifts to the NCCS Annual Fund help to offset the cost of tuition and the full cost of educating an NCCS student. NCCS is a non-profit, 501c3 organization. Gifts to the Annual Fund are considered charitable contributions and are fully tax-deductible.
